6. For orphanage, destitute home (Vidhavashrama and Wrudhasharam) and other centres for down trodden mentally retarded and needy members of the society.
7. To open, found, construct, establish, take over quip, promote, conduct, maintain, support, subsidize, grant, aid and make donations to schools, colleges, pathashalas, hotels, working women's hostels, reading clubs, libraries, art music or literacy societies and other educational institution, associations for imparting or developing, spiritual commercial industrial, legal medical engineering, scientific or other knowledge of training.
8. Grant to endowments at Universities, research institutions and other educational and scientific for spread of education and knowledge in all or any branches of knowledge.
9. Assisting in the promotion of research and development in various fields and or undertaking prosecuting and encouraging higher education and research work in any branch of engineering/medical/law/Ph.D., Horticulture, Agriculture or any other branch of modern science in its widest and most comprehensive sense.

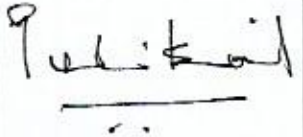






11. Aiding, assisting donating subscribing or otherwise contributing funds to societies, institutions trust and other funds for promoting of any of the forgoing objects.
12. To help widows, orphans, lunatic, indigent persons and the victims of various social evils of the society and to give relief to the poor and distressed disabled destitute etc.
13. To build, equip, take over conduct, maintain and grant aids to dispensaries maternity homes, hospitals, lunatics asylums or any other institutions of the like nature.
14. To erect and maintain dharmasalas, poor house public parks etc.
15. To carry out all acts and things that are incidental or necessary for the promotion of the aforementioned objects with special references to weaker section people and others in general.
16. To promote the well being of humanity by establishing or assisting the formation of, aiding or humanitarian institution and of start, encourage, promote or support the social and economic interest of the people of the world. To unite them in such a manner as may best to ensure the attainments of proper shelter, food and clothing as well as and happiness of the humanity at large.
17. To subscribe to such other charitable objects as the trustees may deem proper provided, however that the donees in such cases are recognised under section 11,12,13 and 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time and/or for such purposes and for such places of archaeological or artistic importance as are notified under 80G (2) of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time.
18. To associate and collaborate with any organisations, Government agencies including international organization in the activities for fulfilling objects of the Trust.
19. To accept donations, grants assistance, subsidy, accept reimbursement or any amount from individuals, government and any organizations including NRI International organizations.


NATURE OF THE TRUST:

This trust shall be irrecoverable and a Public Charitable trust and the properties monies and the income thereof shall be solely applied towards the promotion of the objects for which the Trust is established and no portion thereof shall be distributed as profit among the Trustees and also the author of the Trust shall not utilize any money for the purpose other than to achieve objects of the Trust. The trust is entirely of a Charitable nature.

8. TRUSTEES AND THEIR TENURE OF OFFICE:

The Authors of the Trust will be the trustees. The member of Trustees shall at no time be more than 10. The Management of the Trust shall vest in the Board of Trustees comprising initially.

1. Dr. Fakhruddin Kunil
2. Mrs. Zubaida Kunil
3. Mr. Nasjeb Kunil
4. Dr. Natasha Kunil Baig

All the Four shall be the Trustee for life and they shall have the power to nominate (co-opt) additional Trustees for such specific period. In case any founder Trustees chooses to relinquish the office of the Trust is empowered to nominate any member of his/her choice.

9. APPLICATION OF THE TRUST PROPERTY AND FUNDS:

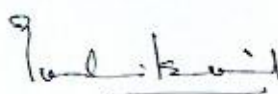

- a) All properties of Trust including the Corpus, the addition and accretion thereto and the Income there from shall be utilized for all or any purposes of the Trust as set out supra an in such manner and to such extent as the trustees may from time to time to determine. No portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the Trustees/Members by way of profits, interest, dividends etc.
- b) All the moneys, which are immediately required shall be invested in conformity with the provisions of the action 11,12 and 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

10. THE POWER OF TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and to all such acts, deeds and things are as calculated to fulfil the objects for which the Trust is established.

Without prejudice to the generality of the forgoing, the Trustee shall have the following powers for purpose of this Trust.

1. To raise funds by contribution, donations from the individual company public or from any other source for the benefits of the Trust or from the Government Agencies, local bodies, co-operative institutions, banks/state finance corporation, individual or from other private sources etc.
2. To acquire by purchase, grant, gift, exchange Lease, higher or otherwise lands, building stocks, shares, securities, movable properties of every other descriptions.

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3. To sell, mortgage, grant or lease higher and otherwise disposes all properties of every other description.
4. To enter into all contracts on behalf of the Trust.
5. To borrow money with or without security and repay the same.
6. To open accounts in banks and provide for its operation by Secretary and Treasurer jointly as may be decided upon by the Board of Trustees from time to time.
7. To receive,, collect an enforce recovery of all moneys dues or payable to the Trust and to grant necessary receipts and discharge therefore.
8. To appoint, terminate ,suspend and otherwise deal with the staff.
9. To appear and represent before courts, tribunals, public officers etc., if necessary,
- 10.To institute prosecute and defend all suits and other legal proceedings.
- 11.To incur all necessary expenses in connection with the Trust and its Management.
- 12.To make rules of the Trust.
- 13.To amend rules and regulations.
- 14.To enrol patrons, nominated Trustees or in such other capacities as the Board of the Trustees may deem fir and to frame rules for enrolment and other matters relating to such position.
- 15.To pay out the Trust funds, Salary wages, Rent for Buildings, Maintenance etc., relating to the Trust and its activities or its other affairs for the management of the Trust.
- 16.To appoint committees, sub-committees from outsiders and/among the members of the Board and assign duties and seek suggestions for the purposes of working of the Trust and frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust and institutions as the board of Trustee may think fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time and to make new rules and regulations which shall not be inconsistent with the terms of these presents, The board trustees shall be entitled to frame constitute and regulate the procedure of such committees.
- 17.The powers enumerated in these presents shall be exercised by the Board of Trustees subject to their satisfying the conditions laid down under section 11,12,13 and 80 (G) of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time so that the income of the trust will be exempt from the income tax for each and every assessment year.
- 18.The powers vested in the board of trustees shall be exercised according to the decision of majority of the members of the board of trustees and by way of resolution passed whether by circulation by the meeting of the board of trustees.
- 19.To prepare and approve the budget.

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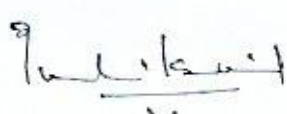
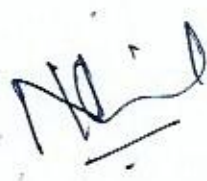

- 20. The day to day administration of the affairs of the Trust is vested with the board of trustees.
- 21. The trustees have power to permit the use of movable or immovable property and assets of the trust by institutions whose objects are similar to those of the trust
- 22. To acquire by lease, purchase, gift, mortgage, license as beneficially in any other trust or otherwise, lands, properties, machinery etc. from the government or semi-government departments, trusts, corporation institutions and societies as well as individuals to sell. Alienate gift, lease mortgage or in any other legal manner to transfer properties belonging to the Trust and also to give the same on lease or license of the furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- 23. To raise secured or unsecured loans from any other scheduled banks. Financial institutions or firms or individuals as and when necessary for furthering the objects of the trust. For this purpose the Board of Trustees shall have the power to secure the assets and properties of the trust to the lending institutions or persons.
- 24. The receive voluntary donation in cash and in kind from individuals, institutions and companies for the purpose of carrying out of the objects of Trust.
- 25. To open a bank account in any schedule Bank including any co-operative bank in the name of the Trust and operate the name in accordance with the resolution of Board of trustees.
- 26. The Board of Trustees shall have power to invest the funds of the trustees in such manner as deemed for trust subject to provision of section 11,12,13 of the Income Tax Act 1961.

11. BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

- 1. Notice of every Board of Trustees meeting specifying the date hours and place of the meeting with the agendas shall be sent to the Trustees at least 15 days before the date fixed for the meeting by circulating the meeting notices or by means of post.
- 2. The trustees who wished to have any subject placed before the Board of Trust meeting shall furnish the same to the secretary in writing not less than seven days before the date fixed for the meeting.
- 3. There shall be at least Four meetings in a calendar year of the Trust. The board shall cause the proceedings of its meetings recorded in a book.
- 4. To adopt the annual report of the secretary and to approve the audited statement of accounts for the previous year and budget for the next year.



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5. All business discussed or decided at the Board of Trustees meeting shall be recorded in the proceedings or minute book, which shall be signed by the President/Secretary and Board of Trust Members.
6. Trustees present at the meeting are only entitled to vote.
7. More than fifty percent of the total members at a given time shall be the quorum for the meeting within an hour from the time appointed for the meeting or minimum two trustees. If quorum is not found, the meeting shall be adjourned to any other convenient date, no notice is necessary for such adjourned meetings.
8. No business shall be transacted at adjourned meeting other than the business left furnished at the meeting from which the adjournment took place. Such adjourned meeting may proceed even through there is no quorum.
9. Voting in all cases shall be in person by showing of hands or by ballot. The Board of Trustees shall from time to time the rules for the conduct of proceedings of meetings.
10. In an extraordinary circumstances the Secretary shall however dispose of urgent matters by circulation among the Trustees or by securing their written opinion or decision and shall be pleased before the next meeting of the Board of Trustees.
11. There can be special meeting of the Trust resolution of the Board of Trustees or by written request of one-third (1/3) of the member of the Trust.
12. An extraordinary Board of Trustees meeting may be called for the Secretary in consultation with the President or in his absence the Vice president to transact the urgent and important matter.
13. The Board of Trustees may constitute sub-committees or adhere committees to promote the object of the Trust.
14. The Board Of Trust shall be simply majority decided all admission, appointments, selection statement of accounts, applications to new course and subjects and other important applications to new course and subjects and other important subjects decided from time to time.

12.. TERMINATION OF TRUSTSHIP

Trustees shall cease to be in office with immediate effect.

- a. All the Trustees shall be resident in India and any Trustee who leaves India permanently shall vacate his office.
- b. On his becoming insolvent
- c. On his becoming instance or incapacitated
- d. On his resignation being accepted by the Board of Trustees and
- e. On his being removed by the Board of Trustees by a resolution adapted by a majority of Board of Trustee personally present in the meeting on the

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ground of such a Trustee has acted against to the object of the Trust and has been given an opportunity of explaining his Conduct.

13.. VACANCY OF THE TRUST:

The Board of Trustees has authority to co-opt any other Trustees with the consent of the majority of Trustees in the vacancy caused subject to the provisions of cause 7. The trustees so appointed should hold the office during the unexpired period of the previous trustees in whose places he co-opted.

13. ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT VICE PRESIDENT SECRETARY & TREASURER:

The Trustees shall elect the among them a President, Vice President a Secretary and treasurer who shall hold office for a period of Three years or until another person's elected to that post and they shall perform such duties as may be assigned to them by the Board of Trustees. In case number of Trustees is only two one shall be the President and another shall be Secretary. The Secretary shall perform the duties of both Secretary and Treasurer.

14.DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

1. PRESIDENT AND HIS POWERS:

- a) The President shall be in overall in charge of the Management of the Trust.
- b) He shall fully supervise and manage the activities and inspect the activities particularly and cause to be inspected the place, of activities and business.
- c) He shall preside over all meetings of the Governing Body and Sub Committees. At meetings of the President shall have the power to cause a casting vote.
- d) He shall recommend top secretary to suspend, remove any staff member for the reason of indiscipline, misbehaviour or misappropriation of funds or negligence of duties etc. subject to ratification of government body.
- e) He shall ensure the finalization of accounts on March 31st March every year and get the approval by the board of Trust.

II VICE PRESIDENT

The Vice President shall exercise all the powers and perform all the functions of the President in his absence or at the request of the President.

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III SECRETARY AND HIS POWERS

- a) The Secretary whom the Board of Trustees elects is purely honorary and he shall maintain all the records, registers, references and accounts properly and up to date.
 - b) He shall be responsible for the proper working and to fix up the duties and responsibility to the staff members and to manage the affairs and also he shall be custodian of all the assets and subcommittee.
 - c) He shall be present in all the meetings and shall be responsible to carry out the decision of the Governing body and committee.
 - d) He shall be fix the date of the meeting of the Governing body or subcommittee in consultation with the President and prepare the agenda for the meeting and give notices.
 - e) He shall record the proceedings of the meetings and preserve such proceedings.
 - f) He shall sign all the bonds and documents etc. along with the president. He shall look after the day to day financial transactions of the Trust.
 - g) He shall be responsible to get the accounts audited by a certified Chartered Accountant annually and preparation of monthly receipt and expenditure statements and get approved in ensuring governing body and also to attend the rectification of the audit observation.
 - h) He shall have to incur the expenditure on contingency not exceeding Rs.500/- at a time. If it exceeds Rs.2,000/- the approval of the governing body is necessary.
- He shall suspend or retrench any staff members in consultation with the President giving One month advance notice wherever necessary for reason of indiscipline of duties subject to the rectification of the Government body.
- He shall attend or cause to be attended on behalf of the Trust in all judicial proceedings in consultation with the president or on the decision of the Government Body.
- He shall perform such other duties as entrusted by the Governing body President and also he is responsible to furnish monthly and annual returns to the concerned authority of the Trust and financial agencies as and when required and to sign the cheques of the Trust along with the Treasurer and to operate the bank accounts jointly.

IV TREASURER

1. The Treasurer shall be the financial officer of the Trust and he has to maintain the accounts of all money received and spent. He shall present the statement of Income and expenditure at the meeting. To make available of all the financial records whenever needed to prepare the

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Sub-Register

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Where a Trustee becomes insolvent or is convicted for an offence by a Court of Law, excepting in the cases where he is acting in a judicial capacity or if in the opinion of Board of Trustees had been detrimental to the interest of the Trust, such Trustee shall tender his resignation and if he does not do so within reasonable time, the Trustee shall have the power to remove him from the Board of Trustees by 2/3rd majority. Any member of the Board may resign for personal reasons, such members shall cease to be the Trustee upon the acceptance of his/her resignation.

20. AMENDMENT CLAUSE

The Trustees shall have powers to alter or amend provisions of this Deed and frame such bye-laws subsidiary rules and regulations and shall have further power to add or amend the same from time to time as may be necessary for the conduct of their business provided that the rules and regulations so framed and amendments so effected are not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust and also to provisions of section 11,12,13 and 80(G) of the Income Tax, 1961 governing Charitable Trusts.

No such amendments shall be carried out without the prior approved of the Commissioner of Income Tax.

21. INDEMNITY

The Trustees shall be kept fully indemnified and harmless by the Trust against them for anything done or committed to be done by them in good faith pursuant to the power and authority conferred on them by these presents.

22. POWER TO DISSOLVE THE TRUST

Board of Trustees shall have the power to dissolve the Trust and transfer all properties, movable and immovable to any other Trust having the same objects of this trust, So, however no property of the Trust should go to the benefits of the Trustees or their relatives.
